Dear Parents/Caregivers,

I wish to first and foremost thank you for your continued support and patience as we pursue to navigate through this current situation.

### **On-site Learning**

As from Monday 4 May 2020, the majority of our students will be learning on-site.

This will mean that students will continue to learn in their regular classes and that practical classes will recommence. As per our previous practices, teachers will continue to upload programs and assessment task onto DayMap for all students. However, this will mean that students who return to on-site learning will no longer have access to teachers via Microsoft Teams.

### **Students Learning from Home**

Students learning from home will access each of their subject classes through Microsoft Teams and participate as part of the regular class. Teachers will communicate with families via email or telephone as required.

### **Other activities**

Please note that activities beyond the classroom such as assemblies, afterschool zoned sport or excursions will not be held. They will recommence once schools are advised by the Department for Education.

### **Health Service Providers**

Please note that currently Health Service Providers will continue to support students remotely or off-site.

### **Canteen**

The canteen will be open as from Monday 4 May 2020. We ask where possible, that students pre-order their recess and/or lunch. This will enable the canteen manager to appropriately restock food supplies. This is particularly important in the first couple of weeks as students continue to transition back to school.

### **Dropping off/picking up of children**

Maintaining social distancing by adults is still advised by our Health Officials. We therefore ask that Parents/Caregivers remain in their cars or outside the gates when dropping off or picking up their children, thank you for your understanding.

### **Students who are unwell**

To continue to maintain a safe environment for both students and staff, please keep your child home if they are unwell. Please understand that under the current circumstances, we will ask you to pick up your child if they present flu like symptoms whilst at school.
