UNIFORM at Hamilton Secondary College

We wish to remind families that in choosing Hamilton Secondary College they undertake to support the college in its expectations for all students to wear the correct uniform as set down by the Governing Council and school community.

The Uniform Policy aims to:

1. create a sense of collective and individual pride in students and their identification with the college
2. provide strategies for individual student health, safety and group security
3. reflect one of the College values – Sense of Community
4. ensure that students are dressed safely and appropriately for school activities.
5. allow staff to be able to identify who is a student of the college.

Students are expected to comply with this uniform policy while travelling to and from the college during college hours and when attending college activities.

College Uniform

Clothing that a student is required to be worn during school hours :

The College Uniform comprises of :

Unisex

Hamilton polo top with college logo.
Hamilton rugby top with college logo.
Hamilton white shirt with college logo.
Hamilton jumper with college logo.
Hamilton jacket with college logo.
Baseball and bucket hats with college logo.

Girls

Blue long pants to be purchased from Uniform shop.
Summer Dress with college logo.
Winter skirt with college logo.
Blue shorts to be purchased from uniform shop.

Boys

Grey long pants to be purchased from uniform shop .
Blue cargo shorts for boys to be purchased from uniform shop.

The College also provides second hand uniform options

Non- College uniform

refers to any items not recommended are part of school uniform with examples listed in this policy

- There are to be no hoodies
- No long sleeves under tops with short sleeves.
- No jackets or track tops that have not been approved by governing council
- Low crotch/surf like pants are not part of the uniform
- No leggings to be worn as trousers or pants
- No track pants / active wear

Students' appearance in uniform should be neat, clean and worn in a conventional manner. The wearing of other garments is incorrect uniform and therefore seen as unacceptable. Students who choose not to wear the official College uniform on any day may be unable to participate in College activities.

Non Compliance

The disciplinary measures used to enforce this Uniform Policy will be consistent with Hamilton's non compliance behavior management policy.
